21%

LINK passenger trips increased 21% in program year FY13-14. The LINK services have shown double digit increases for five years in a row.

In 2008 Workforce Solutions for the Heart of Texas secured the region's first Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) grant from TXDOT. Fifty percent of all LINK services are funded through this grant and the other 50% comes from Workforce Solutions and a dozen other public and private partners including Sanderson Farms, MCC, TSTC, Falls Community Hospital & Clinics, and others.

The Marlin LINK is the low-cost public transportation service for residents of Riesel, Marlin, Chilton, Golinda, and Robinson. The service connects riders to all of the Waco Transit routes, Greyhound, and service to Sanderson Farms.

The Late-Evening Sanderson Farms LINK provides employees living in Waco and working the 4:30 PM – 12:30 AM shift with a safe ride home at night.

The Evening LINK is an employment transportation service available to ANYONE who works and lives in the Greater Waco Area and needs a ride to or from work between the hours of 8:30 PM and 11:30 PM. Reservations are required for this door-to-door service.
